NSW Health will be conducting hearing checks for all students tomorrow, Tuesday, 21 May 2019. Please make sure students are at school by 9.00am.

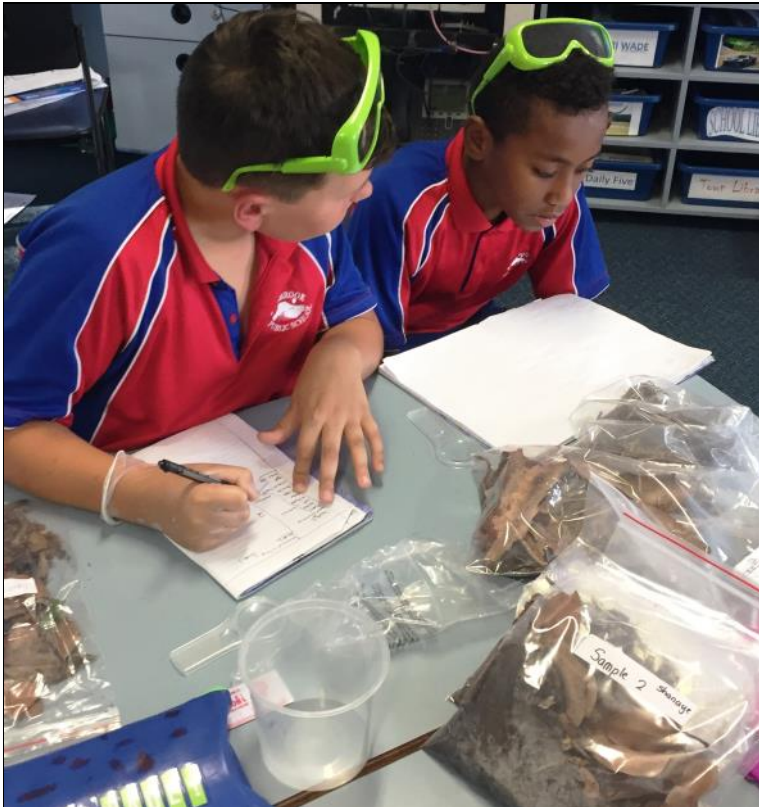
