Online enrolment for new students is now available at our school! If your child lives within the local intake area of our school, you can make an application for enrolment through our school website under the 'Enrolment' tab.

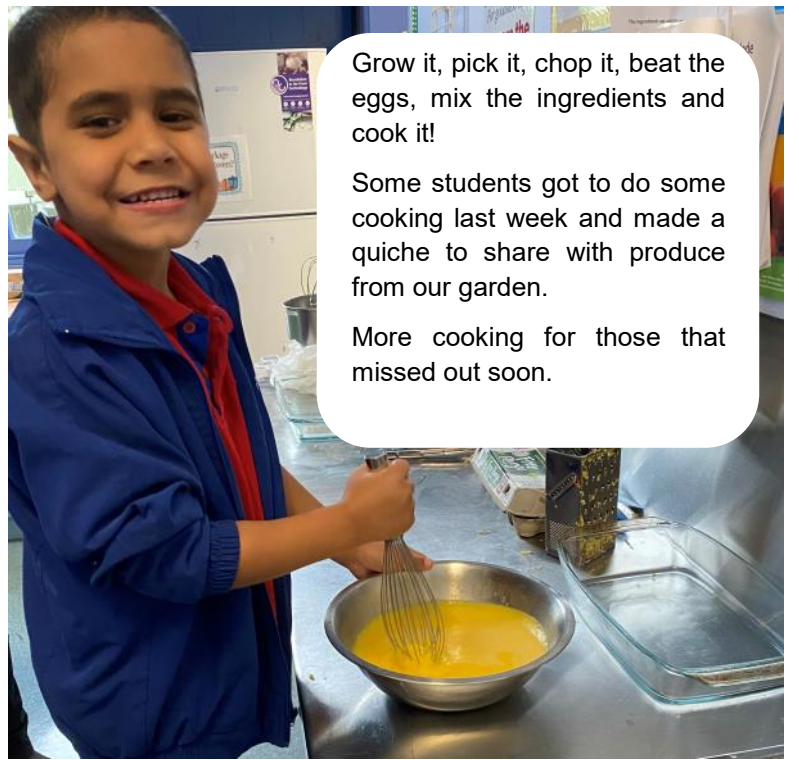
We have been working with the P&C to produce a 2021 calendar which will be available for sale shortly. Keep in mind as it makes a great gift idea for Christmas and helps support our school.
